- Regardless of presentation styles (oral or poster), all contributing authors are requested to submit a one-page abstract that includes the title of paper, author(s), e-mail address of the corresponding author and affiliations in Microsoft word format.
- The abstract should be typed in English, using A4 page format (210-297 mm).
- The file size must not exceed 7MB, including tables, figures etc.
